JUNIOR LEAGUE OF HIGH POINT TO HOLD 90 HOUR VOLUNTEER-A-THON

High Point, NC, October 31, 2018– To honor the Junior League of High Point’s (JLHP) ninety year legacy of service to High Point, League members will be participating in ninety consecutive hours of signature projects and partnerships to aid and assist the community. The *90 Hours for 90 Years Volunteer-a-thon* will start Thursday, November 8th and continue through Monday, November 12th.

“The Junior League of High Point kicked off 2018 with a series of community celebrations commemorating our 90th anniversary,” says Dr. Sadie Leder Elder, President of the Junior League of High Point. *“It feels right to close out the year with a service project that draws attention to our nearly century-long history of service to the city of High Point.”*

During this event, the Junior League will host signature projects like their Baby Basics care-packaging event, which partners with the YWCA’s Women’s Resource Center, and Dinner-with-the-League, which partners with local shelters like the Salvation Army’s Center for Hope. Through the volunteer-a-thon, the JLHP will also partner with other nonprofit organizations to assist their ongoing efforts by providing a dedicated group of volunteers to work on short-term projects.

“We are excited to work with partners like the American Red Cross, Cover the City Project, GoFar, the High Point Public Library, and the High Point Theater,” says Elder.

Taken as a whole, the Junior League of High Point’s *90 Hours for 90 Years Volunteer-a-thon* involves the collaboration and support of more than a dozen community programs and will engage not just League members, but countless others in the community.
