HIGH POINT, NC – March 8, 2017 – A new luxury bed and breakfast and event space in High Point will soon be unveiling its recently renovated bedrooms, each of which has undergone many months of custom work from high-profile interior designers Thom Filcia, Alexa Hampton, Celerie Kemble, Tobi Fairley, Barclay Butera, and Madcap Cottage.

The myriad of styles represents the looks of each designer, while being housed in a beautiful Colonial Revivalist home.

Boutique B&B Pandora's Manor is in a 110-year-old High Point home, providing visitors with easy access to Market Square, High Point University, and the downtown area. The new makeover highlights the home's period features, such as its original tall windows, hardwood floors, and wraparound porch, while incorporating on-trend interiors.
